

Copyright Policy for HCSB®

The text of the HCSB®, may be quoted in any form (written, visual, electronic, or audio) up to and inclusive of one thousand (1,000) verses without the written permission of the publisher, provided that the verses quoted do not account for more than 50 percent (50%) of the work in which they are quoted, and provided that a complete book of the Bible is not quoted.

When the HCSB is quoted, one of the following credit lines must appear on the copyright page or title page of the work:

2. As a general rule, follow the naming standards set by B & H Publishing Group when referring to the HCSB®, translation. The preferred forms are HCSB when indicating Scripture references.

Products with multiple translations:

“After looking around at them all, He told him, ‘Stretch out your hand.’ He did so, and his hand was restored” (Luke 6:10, HCSB).

Products with HCSB as the only or primary translation:

“After looking around at them all, He told him, ‘Stretch out your hand.’ He did so, and his hand was restored” (Luke 6:10).

4. Use of the registered trademark symbol ® in running text or with Scripture references is not necessary when the symbol appears in the masthead, copyright page, or title page information.

5. Use of the registered trademark symbol ® is only necessary on the first mention of the HCSB in promotional copy (ads, brochures, catalogs, flyers, posters, etc.) or other running text separate from a product.
