READ

Read 2 Timothy 1:3-7; 3:14-15. These verses tell us a bit about two other women in the Bible: Lois & Eunice, the grandmother and mother of Timothy. They taught Timothy to love God and His Word from the time he was a little boy, so He grew up to be a great missionary and share the love of Jesus far and wide. Just like Lois and Eunice, you can teach other people about Jesus too-He will use your life to share His love.

THINK

- 1. These Bible women lived a long, long time ago and in a place that is much different than where most of us live. Why are their stories still important?
- 2. If you had to pick one of these women as a role model, which would you pick? Why?
- 3. Some of these stories are about women who sinned and did not put God first in their lives. Why do you think God included their stories in the Bible too?
- 4. Think about some of the character traits you learned from these biblical women. Pick one trait each week and try to grow it and show it in your daily life.
- 5. Did these stories teach you more about what God is like? If an unbelieving friend asked you to describe your God, what would you say?
- 6. How does it feel when you hear your parents say a prayer for you? Next time they pray for you, surprise them and say a prayer for them too.
- 7. Pretend you are writing a story about the rest of your life. Who would be in it? What would happen? Could girls who one day read the story learn lessons from your life about how to live for Jesus?
