REMEMBER

“For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” Romans 10:13

READ

In John 4, you’ll meet a woman who was much like our Little Tree. She was sad and lonely and thirsting for life. Then she meets Jesus. He offers her living water, a water that when given “will become a well of water springing up within [her] for eternal life” (v. 14). Jesus offers this to you and me too—forgiveness and true life through His grace and never-ending love.

THINK

1. What was Little Tree searching for?
2. Why did Little Tree get sick and begin to die?
3. How did the father and son change Little Tree’s life?
4. Who do you think the father and son represent in real life?
5. Do you ever feel like Little Tree? How?

DO

Make a hotline to heaven!

1. Ask an adult to help you get a clean tin can with no sharp edges.
2. Cut a piece of paper large enough to wrap around the can.
3. On the paper, write the words of Romans 10:13.
4. Decorate the paper and wrap it around the can, using tape to secure the edges.
5. Tape a piece of yarn or string to the end of the can—or go wireless!
6. Now, talk into the can like a speakerphone. Tell God what you’re thinking, what you’ve learned about His promises. (You can also put your ear to the can to listen, but the best way to hear God is with your heart and mind.)
7. Talk to an adult in your home or at church about Romans 10:13.

Of course, your tin-can hotline is really just to remind you that God is always there. You’ve always had a hotline to heaven—and you always will. You can call on Him anytime or anywhere for anything at all. And when you ask Him, you will be saved. Calling on the name of the Lord is the most important call you’ll ever make!
