READ

DO

Draw your own look-and-find story.

1. Get a large sheet of paper and markers or colored pencils.
2. Choose a story from the Bible that is not included in this book. (Need a suggestion? Try Daniel 6, Jonah 1-4, or Matthew 19:13-15.)
3. Illustrate a scene from the story, using lots of details and colors.
4. In the margin of the page, create a list of items to find in the illustration.
5. Share the Bible story with your friends. See if they can find all of the items hidden in your look-and-find story.
