REMEMBER

READ

In Luke 15:11–32, you can read another parable about a father who loves his child. There Jesus tells the story of the prodigal son who runs away from his father and makes many bad decisions. When the son finally goes home, he is worried that his father no longer loves him. But his father welcomes him back—just like God does for us! He loves us no matter what.

THINK

- 1. Why does the princess want to run away? Do you think she has a good reason to leave the palace?
- 2. How do you usually answer your parents when they ask you to do a chore you don't like?
- 3. Is the princess a good example for the children she meets in the neighborhood?
- 4. The King loves the princess very much—a lot like how God loves us! Can you name some other ways that God is like the King in the story?
- 5. Is there anything you could do that would make God stop loving you? What helpful thing can you do today to thank your family for their love and care?
