REMEMBER

“Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of Mine, you did for Me.” Matthew 25:40

READ

Jesus tells the parable of the Good Samaritan in Luke 10:25-37. He gives this as an example of how we should serve. No matter how different, how dirty, or how desperate others may seem, we are to be a neighbor to them all. As a kid, sometimes it can feel difficult to make a big difference, but watch for the people God sends your way. You may just be surprised at how much of a difference those two little hands can make.

THINK

1. Have you made your Christmas list this year? What are you asking for?
2. Why do you think the boy in the story is making a different kind of Christmas list this year?
3. How do you think he learned about those people in need?
4. What is he doing to be a neighbor to others?
5. Who do you know that needs a little help right now?

DO

Make your own Christmas list.

1. Get a piece of Christmassy paper or decorate your own.
2. Write “My Christmas List” at the top.
3. Make a list of at least five people or groups in your town or around the world who could use some help.
4. When you’re finished, pray for each person or group on your list.
5. Talk to your parents or a church leader about helping them.
6. Hang the list on the fridge or a bathroom mirror and pray for those people every time you see your list.
