READ

You can find the whole story of Noah in Genesis 6–9. You’ll hear the exact directions God gave to Noah for building the ark. You’ll see the animals that came aboard with Noah and his family. You’ll learn how the birds helped Noah to know when the land was dry enough to leave the ark. But most importantly, you’ll read the true meaning of the rainbow and God’s promise to us all.

THINK

1. How do you think Noah felt when God asked him to build an ark?
2. What do you think Noah’s family said to him?
3. What would you say if God had asked you to build an ark?
4. What do you think Noah and his family learned after the flood?
5. What can you learn from Noah’s decision to obey God?

DO

Make a Rainbow Reminder

1. On a white sheet of paper, write (or ask an adult to write) the memory verse above.
2. Cut around the verse in the shape of a cloud.
3. Using construction paper (or coloring white paper with crayons), cut on strip each of red, orange, yellow, green, blue, and purple.
4. In the order listed above, tape or glue the colors to hang from the bottom of the cloud.
5. Hang your Rainbow Reminder in the window or someplace where it will always remind you of God’s promises.
