REMEMBER

"But when you pray, go into your private room, shut your door, and pray to your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you." – Matthew 6:6

READ

While Jesus was on earth, He spent a lot of time praying to God. Read Matthew 26:36 and Mark 14:32. These two verses in the Bible tell us about one of Jesus' favorite places to pray – the Garden of Gethsemane. Sometimes He chose to pray in a quiet place like the garden so that He could be alone and talk to God easily. Because of our relationship with Jesus, we get to pray to God too! And no matter where we are, God hears us.

THINK

1. Have you prayed in any of the same places where Peter tried to pray?
2. Where is your favorite place to pray? Why?
3. How is praying different than talking to your friends? How is it the same?
4. Can you name ten different places where you could pray each day? Count them on your fingers.
5. Did you know there are different types of prayers? Think about if God has heard these prayers from you:
 - A prayer that says "thank you" to God
 - A prayer asking God to help someone else
 - A prayer asking God for His blessing or protection
 - A prayer that praises God and says "I love you" to Him
 - A prayer that says "I'm sorry"
