REMEMBER

For God loved the world in this way: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.—John 3:16

READ

Just before Jesus returned to heaven, He gave His disciples a great commission. This means that He gave all of His followers, even those who live today, a very important job. You can read the great commission in Matthew 28:16–20. Jesus came to save us all from sin. But He also taught us how to live in a way that pleases God. Our very important job is to share everything about Jesus. He wants everyone to know that He came to save us and that God wants us to live a life of obedience to Jesus. Sharing this big news with the whole world may sound scary, but Jesus reminds us, “I am with you always, to the end of the age.”
