REMEMBER

READ

Time. Everyone has it, but do we use it wisely? In Deuteronomy 6:5, God reveals how He wants us to use our time. It is the greatest of all His commandments: "Love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength." Every moment, from morning to night, is an opportunity to love and glorify God. Verses 6-7 explain that we can do that by keeping God's words in our heart, by talking about them wherever we go, and by obeying them in all that we do. God doesn't want to be just one part of our life—He wants our whole life to be lived through Him.

- 2. Which of the Old Testament heroes is your favorite, and why?
- 3. How did that person trust in God?
- 4. What do all the stories of the Old Testament and New Testament have in common?

- 6. The heroes of the Bible often had to be brave for God. What are some ways you can be brave enough to tell others about Him?
- 7. If you've got five minutes, what can you do for Jesus?
