READ

DO

Create a Snow Mobile.

- 1. Cut a sheet of white paper into fourths.
- 2. Fold each piece into fourths (in half and in half again).
- 3. While still folded, cut small shapes and designs out of the edges. (Be careful not to cut the entire folded edge.)
- 4. Unfold each paper to reveal your snowflake!
- 5. Write a winter blessing on the front and back of each snowflake.
- 6. Hang the four snowflakes at different lengths from the bottom of a clothes hanger.
- 7. Hang your snow mobile in the window for winter blessings all season long!

Find the miracle in each snowflake.
