REMEMBER

All Scripture is inspired by God and is profitable for teaching, for rebuking, for correcting, for training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

-2 Timothy 3:16-17

READ

Read Psalm 119:11. The psalmist declares that he has "treasured" or "hidden" (NIV) God's Word in his heart so that he can keep from sinning. Sometimes it can be difficult to know if something is a sin. Parents and teachers can help guide us, but the best source for learning right and wrong, and what makes something a sin, is the Bible—God's Word. If we don't study God's Word—read it, understand it, remember it—then we are ultimately relying on the opinions of others to determine what is acceptable. We can't be sure to do what is right in God's eyes unless we know what He says is right. So spend some time with your Bible, and if you need help to understand what it means, ask an adult you can trust. Once you know what your Bible says, you can use that knowledge to live the way God wants you to live. That's how you treasure God's Word.
