REMEMBER

Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord.—1 Corinthians 1:31

READ

Morty and Maggie were doing a good thing when they gave away their things to the poor. So how did things go so wrong? How did they end up fighting with each other over who was the better giver? Read James 4:1. This Scripture says that when we fight with others it is because the things we want become more important to us than what God wants. Morty and Maggie weren't happy just being generous, they wanted to be praised for it too. When they started boasting, they started fighting. Sin always causes beautiful things to turn ugly. Thankfully, God's Word helped Morty and Maggie learn to boast only in the Lord, and it can help us too.
