


Character Card Games

Print and cut out two sets of cards.












Sam Snail


- 9 years old

Games to play with your character cards:

Charades

One person will choose a card and act out that character while other players guess which character the person is. Whoever guesses correctly goes next! (Play with one set of all 8 characters.)

Guess Who?

One person draws a card and reads the bio of the character without showing the card. The first person to call out the correct answer wins that card. The person with the most cards at the end wins the game. (Play with one set of all 8 characters.)

Memory

Turn all cards facedown. Players take turns flipping over two cards at a time as they try to make a match. The player with the most matches at the end wins! (Play with all 16 cards.)

Go Sticker

Deal the cards evenly between players. When it is each player's turn, the player asks another player for a card to make a match. If the player does not have the card the other player is asking for, the player says, "Go sticker!" The person with the most matches in the end is the winner. (Play with all 16 cards.)

Color the Snails imagining their family moving to the Land of Happiness.






About the Authors
