‘The heavens declare the glory of God.’ Psalm 19:1 ESV

READ [For Kids]

Did you know that the world God has made can talk? No, not in the same way humans do—there is a limit to what creation can say and what it can speak about. But the Bible does say that God’s creation “declares” and “proclaims” (Psalm 19:1).

What does creation say? *Why* does creation say it?

The biblical doctrine of General Revelation helps us answer these questions. Read Romans 1:20: “For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made.”

This means that even though creation doesn’t tell us about Jesus, it does point us to God and reveals parts of God’s attributes and character. God is invisible (1 Timothy 1:17), but He has made his invisible attributes known to us through what He has made!

For believers in Jesus Christ, *General Revelation* calls them both to praise God and tell others about Him. Believers who also trust in God’s Special Revelation, the Bible, can help people understand what they see in creation and how that points us to God.

THINK [For Kids]

1. What are three of your favorite things that God has made?
2. What do these marvelous things tell you about God?
3. Colossians 1:16 says that God, through His Son, Jesus, created all things—everything we can see and even everything we cannot see, every mountain and every molecule.
 - Take a minute and tell God how thankful you are for the things He has made and how much you enjoy them.
 - Take a minute and praise God for His work through His Son, Jesus, for all of us.
