REMEMBER

"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" Matthew 28:19

READ

Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-4. In this passage, Paul tells the good news: Jesus died for our sins and rose from the dead to save us! This good news is called *the gospel*. When we believe the gospel, God changes our hearts, and we will live forever with Jesus. Then we get to share the good news with others, just like Paul did! We can't keep this good news to ourselves—it's too good! As you learned in *Go Tell Everyone*, Jesus told Christians to go all around the world and tell everyone this good news. One day, Jesus will come back, and Christians from every country in the world will worship Him together (Revelation 7:9-10). That's because when someone told each of those Christians the good news, they believed it!

- 2. Which missionary story in *Go Tell Everyone* was your favorite and why?
- 3. If you could go anywhere in the world to share the good news, where would you go?
- 4. The Bible tells us that people can't believe the good news unless we share it with them (Romans 10:14-15). Can you practice sharing the good news?
- 5. Wherever we are, we can share the good news. Who are some people in your life with whom you can share it?
- 6. Do you know any missionaries? Even if you don't, you can still pray for missionaries who are sharing the good news around the world today.
